NOTICE TO APPLICANTS ADDENDUM NO. ONE (1)

ROOKERY BAY NATIONAL ESTUARINE RESEARCH RESERVE ISLE OF CAPRI ENVIRONMENTAL SITE WORK

TO BIDDERS AND PLAN HOLDERS ON THE ABOVE REFERENCED PROJECT:

The following statements supersede and supplant the corresponding items in the
specifications/drawings:

- 1.) Question: How far away is the landfill from the site?

Answer: The site is located at the corner of Isle of Capri Boulevard and County Road 951, in Collier County. The address for this project has yet to be established by Collier County. It is the contractor's responsibility to determine travel routes and distances to the appropriate landfill.

- 2.) Question: After the dirt is cleaned how far does it have to be transported?

Answer: The reclaimed soil is to be relocated to an existing, onsite clean fill stockpile. It is the contractor's responsibility to determine travel routes and distances.

- 3.) Question: Is there an estimated amount of truck loads of trash coming out to take to landfill?

Answer: It is the contractor's responsibility to conduct their own estimates to determine quantities.

- 4.) Question: Is it solely household trash or is there large debris found in it?

Answer: The onsite contaminates have been classified as household trash by the FDEP District office in Ft. Myers. It is the contractor's responsibility to evaluate the onsite debris.

- 5.) Question: Is FDEP paying for the disposal fees? If so, what landfill will the trash be going to?

Answer: The Scope of Work indicates that all Collier County Landfill fees will be paid directly by the Department and should **Not** be included in the bid price. The Collier County Landfill is located at 3750 Landfill Road, Naples, FL. 34117.

- 6.) Question: Will a Pollutant Storage Contractors License be enough to cover the current required licensure specifications.

Answer: The Department has specified the types of licenses that are known to be acceptable by the governing county; however, the Department will accept other licensed contractors, if the Contractor can produce a written letter of acceptance from the county which states the county's acceptance of a license other than the licenses listed in the specifications. This acceptance letter **MUST** be in writing and received by the Department with the contractor's Sealed Bid.

In all other respects, the contract documents of which this is an Addendum, and attachments relative thereto, shall remain in full force and effect.

NOTICE

It will be required that this addendum be signed in acknowledgment of receipt and that it be attached to Bid when same is submitted to Michael Renard, Construction Projects Administrator II, Bureau of Design and Construction, 3540 Thomasville Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32309. Failure to do so may be grounds for rejection of the Bid.
