2020 NSLP Equipment Assistance Grant Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

- Q. If the quote comes in at \$125,000 can we still request, but just to the max of \$100,000?
- A. Yes, you may still request the equipment even though the amount is above the max award.
- Q. Hi. Did you say in the beginning that in order to EVEN apply, we have to have 50% or more students free or reduced?
- A. No. We encourage all sponsors to apply even if the site has a free and reduced-price percentage less than 50%. The higher the free and reduced-price percentage increases the chance of award.
- Q. On the Equipment request form, it asks if "sponsor has previously received this grant" Is that relating to the specific equipment on that sheet, or in general?
- A. Sites that have not previously been awarded the EAG will have priority over those sites that have previously received the award. This is a general statement referring to the site as a whole and not the equipment requested.
- Q. If we need more spaces than available is it allowable to use two pages for the number of sites
- A. Yes, you must use the equipment request template but you may duplicate this page as needed.
- Q. Will you send the slides of this presentation?
- A. This presentation will be available on the Vendor Bid System as an Addendum Questions and Answers.
- Q. What does FEIN in the submission of the assurances?
- A. The FEIN is the same as the FEID located in FANS under the Profile Module.
- Q. So to clarify, we lose points if we have previously applied for the grant, but requesting a "new" equipment on this application?
- A. Yes, a site that has previously received an award will receive less points than a site that has not received an award. The Request for Application list the scoring for the year the grant was previously awarded under the Evaluation Criteria section (page 7).
